## About This Map

This map was produced collaboratively by the ChampaignCountyBikes.org and League of Illinois Bicyclists with input from the Cities of Urbana and Champaign and the University of Illinois. It is intended to encourage bicycling as a healthy and enjoyable form of recreation and an energy-efficient, economical, and non-polluting form of transportation.

The map identifies off-road trails and suggests on-road routes for bicycle travel throughout the Champaign-Urbana area. The roads shown in the network are rated using three relative levels of cyclist comfort. These ratings are to be used by adult cyclists, who have at least a moderate level of traffic tolerance. (Other cyclists may choose other routes appropriate for their abilities.)

As much as possible, roads with lower traffic volume and speed, ample width, and fewer stop signs are identified as preferred routes. Intersections with stoplights were preferred for crossing the busiest streets (circled intersections indicate difficult, unsignalized crossings). Though many of the streets are less than ideal, local cyclists judged them as the best available in an area.

Map users are encouraged to read the safety tips included, to help become a more skillful, confident, and safer bicyclist.
